

## **RECLAIMED WATER FROM STANDPIPES**

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

El Paso Water Utilities encourages you to help conserve potable water by using reclaimed water for non-potable uses such as for construction and irrigation. Reclaimed water from standpipes costs a fraction of the price of potable water and is available from the following locations (see map on back of this page and attached application):

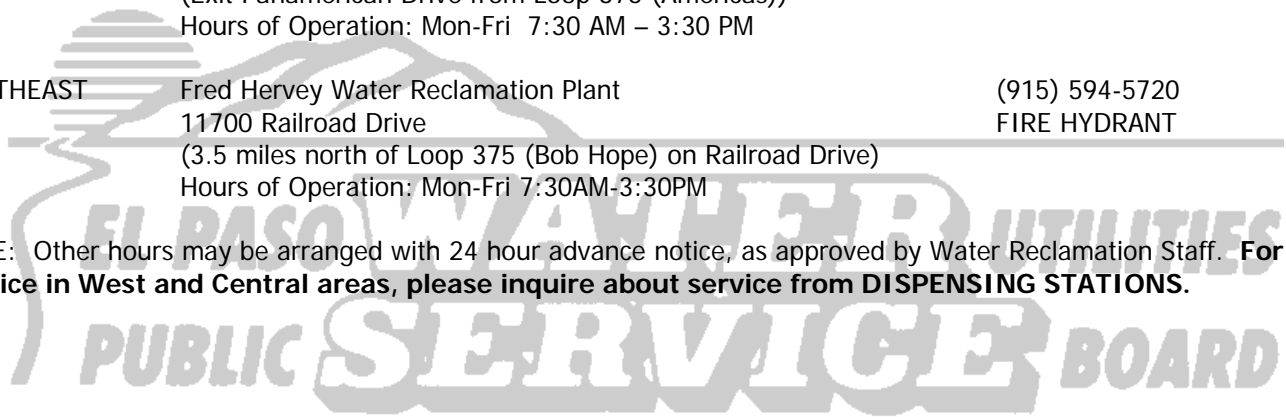

#### **RECLAIMED WATER RATES AND BILLING:**

Reclaimed water rate is 70% of lowest potable water rate. Effective March 1, 2009 to February 28, 2010, this reclaimed water rate is equivalent to **\$1.24 per 1,000 gallons** (\$0.93 per ccf or 100 cubic feet) of reclaimed water.

Reclaimed water from Standpipes will be billed on an "HONOR" system based on the amount stated by the customer on the application. For extended use (over 30 days), an application must be filled out and submitted on a monthly basis, at least 48 hours prior to expiration of a previously approved application.

#### **RECLAIMED WATER APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

Attached is the application to use reclaimed water. Please complete the application and submit it in person or via facsimile to the following EPWU location at least 48 hours prior to use. A current and approved application and a valid official identification are required for access to the standpipe.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

Adhere to the El Paso Water Utilities – Public Service Board Rules and Regulations for the Use and Payment of Reclaimed Water. The following conditions apply:

- Each distribution vehicle shall be identified by labels or signs such as "CAUTION – RECLAIMED WATER DO NOT DRINK" in English and Spanish. They shall be placed so that they can be seen readily by all operations personnel using the vehicle.
- Reclaimed Water used for the purpose of soil compaction and/or dust control shall not be stored or applied in a manner that causes runoff or ponding, in accordance to State regulations (30TAC210).
- Excess reclaimed water may not be discharged into storm drain systems, ponds, rivers, etc.
- Contractor will be billed at the current reclaimed water rates based on the usage listed on this application. One CCF is equivalent to 748 gallons.
- Reclaimed water service can be stopped at any time due to nonpayment or not following rules.
- Gates at Fred Hervey and Bustamante Plants will be closed 30 minutes after the hours of operation indicated on this application, unless special arrangements are made at least 24 hours in advance.
- For security purposes, every person accessing the treatment plants will be required to present a current approved application, current valid picture identification, and to sign-in at the Security Booth upon entrance.
