TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

Adhere to the El Paso Water Utilities – Public Service Board Rules and Regulations for the Use and Payment of Reclaimed Water. The following conditions apply:

- Each distribution vehicle shall be identified by labels or signs such as "CAUTION – RECLAIMED WATER DO NOT DRINK" in English and Spanish. They shall be placed so that they can be seen readily by all operations personnel using the vehicle.
- Reclaimed Water used for the purpose of soil compaction and/or dust control shall not be stored or applied in a manner that causes runoff or ponding, in accordance to State regulations (30TAC210).
- Excess reclaimed water may not be discharged into storm drain systems, ponds, rivers, etc.
- Contractor will be billed at the current reclaimed water rates based on the usage listed on this application. Reclaimed water rate from Northwest Plant, Haskell R. Street, and Bustamante Plants is billed at 60% of the lowest potable water rate in effect. Reclaimed water from Fred Hervey Plant is billed at 80% of the lowest potable water rate in effect. One CCF is equivalent to 748 gallons.
- Reclaimed water service can be stopped at any time due to nonpayment or not following rules.
- Gates at Haskell R. Street and Fred Hervey Plants will be closed 30 minutes after the hours of operation indicated on this application, unless special arrangements are made with the Plant Superintendent in advance.
- For security purposes, every person accessing the treatment plants will be required to present current valid picture identification and sign-in at the Security Booth upon entrance.
